- 6.1 To receive information regarding the use of S137 for the purchase of the Chairs Chain of Office**
The Clerk highlighted that there is no specific power to purchase a chain of office however it would fall under s137 expenditure, therefore a retrospective minute of the purchase back in May to say the purchase was made under s137 is required.
This was AGREED by ALL.
- 6.2 To receive an update on the proposed legacy volunteer group following the ending of the Coronavirus Support Group**
A new group, Bramhope Village Volunteers (BVV) will be set up and run from 1st August. This is a legacy group from Bramhope Coronavirus Community Help and will perform the same functions as the previous group but can also help with issues such as recently discharged hospital patients needing shopping etc, while they recover.
- 6.3 To receive an update on the X84/X85 service.**
All stop on the route have now been re-instated following our letter to First Bus.
Cllr Harris noted that the wearing of masks on the X84 route was not being enforced and had written to First Bus regarding the matter as a member of the public to raise her concerns. First Bus have indicated that their drivers do not have any enforcing powers but have now been issued with notices to give to passengers boarding without a face mask.
