4. **To receive an update from the Neighbourhood Police Team**  
PCSO Joel Hebden joined the meeting. In the last 30 days there have been 3 crimes reported. No house burglaries. Two business burglaries. One attempted burglary. The neighbourhood police team have been monitoring parking and road safety at Bramhope Primary School and addressing any inconsiderate or unsafe parking.

6. **To receive information on the ongoing issues**
  - 6.1 **To receive an update on a Breeze event for Bramhope & Carlton 2022**  
There have been some changes to how the Breeze events are being run this year. There will be two x two and a half hour sessions. Numbers are capped at 500 per event with the events being pre-bookable at £1 per family to book. All events held within school holidays. The events are also being used as an opportunity to promote local groups and businesses, for example local business providing food at the events. Young performers are being encouraged to attend to show off their talents. The dates will be confirmed in May. The event has been mentioned to Bramhope in Bloom who are considering whether they would like to attend. Breeze will provide flyers and banners and the Parish Council will advertise on the website and social media.
  - 6.2 **To receive an update on the planning application for the pavilion refurbishment and extension**  
The decision date for the planning application has been extended by a further week, so a decision should be received towards the end of next week.
  - 6.3 **To discuss the briefing from NALC regarding Ukraine and agree the Councils response to the crisis**  
A discussion took place regarding how the council can respond to the crisis in Ukraine. It was PROPOSED by Cllr Rider and SECONDED by Cllr Robinson that a donation should be made to support the crisis.
